



Craig Schulz was born in Minneapolis, Minn. in 1953, the middle child of 5, (Meredith, Monte, Amy, and Jill.)

The family moved to Sebastopol in 1958 and he has remained here ever since. He attended El Molino High School in the late 60's.

He learned to fly airplanes right out of High School and then proceeded to fly helicopters

Prior to getting married in 1979, he became a flight instructor at the Sonoma County Airport. He later started his own charter company, Woodstock Aviation, and would fly his father and others in the private jet they owned.

His most famous flight was when he volunteered to fly to Mexico City to retrieve Ramon Salcido, Sonoma County's most notorious mass murderer.

Craig also was called upon to use his talents of film editing to make films for some local schools as well as Sutter VNA & Hospice and also for Memorial Hospital's EICU.

He is the President of Creative Associates, and oversees the Peanuts business. He is on the board of the Charles M. Schulz museum.

He and his wife Judy created all the *free* events that take place during the year at Snoopy's Home Ice.

He brought Peanuts on Parade to Santa Rosa for 3 years and headed up the encore "Lucy" year in 2009.

Lastly, he co-wrote and produced a new Peanuts TV special that was released on DVD in 2011, in partnership with, Warner Bros. and Wildbrain.
